**Nominations for the appointment of an additional
Frogmore ward Parish Councillor**

Your opportunity to join the Parish Council

The parish council's constitution provides for three Sherford Councillors and up to five Frogmore Councillors. Following the May 2023 local elections, Frogmore and Sherford Parish Council has a vacancy for an additional Frogmore ward Councillor.

Representation of the People legislation entitles the presently elected Councillors to co-opt a further person to fill the vacancy.

Candidate qualifications

The minimum age is 18 years old.

Councillors are to be British or eligible Commonwealth citizens.

Councillors are to meet at least one of the following four qualifications:

- You are, and will continue to be, registered as a local government elector for the parish/community in which you wish to stand from the day of your co-option onwards.
- You have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the parish/community area during the whole of the 12 months before the date of co-option.
- Your main or only place of work during the 12 months prior to the date of co-option has been in the parish/community area.
- You have lived in the parish/community area or within three miles of it during the whole of the 12 months before the date of co-option.

Applications and Timetable for Co-option

- Candidates are invited to submit a short curriculum vitae noting their local community interests and involvement and the potential strengths and skills which they would be able to bring to the Parish Council team.
- All eligible candidates will be offered an interview with parish councillors, to be convened by mutual agreement, on or before Friday 8th September with the appointment being made on or before the 18th September 2023 Parish Council meeting.
